SAFELY SHARING OUR ROADS AND HIGHWAYS

When you visit the Territory you will be sharing our roads and highways with road trains.

- > If you need to pass or overtake a road train, remember that they can be more than 50 metres long.
- > Road trains are big and heavy and may move around on the road more than other vehicles.
- > If you are being overtaken by a road train, maintain your speed and position on the road.
- > Road trains take longer to stop, so don't cut in front of them when they are braking.
